

**Proof of General equivalency courses – General Level 1 license**

<b>Course equivalent</b>	<b>Proof required by AIC</b>
a) Proof of passing the C11 (Principles and Practice of Insurance) (or credit granted) and C130 (Essential Skills for the Insurance Broker and Agent) courses of the Insurance Institute of Canada.	Copy of official IIC transcript as proof that the last exam was passed within 12 months of the application submission
b) Proof of having the Full Chartered Insurance Professional ('CIP') Designation	Copy of the CIP designation and IIC transcript as proof that the last exam was passed within 12 months of the application submission
c) Proof of passing the Canadian Accredited Insurance Broker - CAIB 1 <u>and</u> 2 courses	Copy of official transcript or signed CAIB letter with proof that the last exam was passed within 12 months of the application submission
d) Proof of having the Full CAIB Designation with proof that the last exam was passed within 12 months of the submission of an application for licensing to the AIC.	Copy of CAIB designation as proof that the last exam was passed within 12 months of the application submission

Note: Answer “yes” to question 3 of the application that asks, “Have you ever been licensed as an insurance agent in Alberta or elsewhere?” and attach proof of your official transcript and/or designation as a PDF. The document must indicate your name and the courses.
