The role

AIC is seeking a collaborative and detail-oriented Education Manager who will foster a culture of quality, consistency, and continuous improvement, while effectively liaising with internal teams, education providers, and stakeholders. They are passionate about regulatory compliance, upholding education standards, and contributing to AIC's operational excellence.

- Bachelor's degree in education, public administration, business, or a related discipline.
- Experience with examination administration, instructional design, or adult learning principles is an asset.
- Certification in project or change management (e.g., PMP, PROSCI) or quality assurance is considered an asset.
- Possession of a Management or Supervisory Certificate OR completion of coursework in management, supervision, or a closely related field is an asset.
