Call for Nominations for Election to the Life Insurance Council

The Alberta Insurance Council is seeking nominations to fill the position of Life Insurance Agent with the Life Insurance Council.

Do you know an eligible colleague?

If so, send us your nomination today! To be considered candidates must:

- reside in Alberta;
- be engaged in the insurance business, hold a Life Insurance Certificate of Authority, and have held the certificate for the five years before the election;
- not have been convicted of an offence under the *Insurance Act* (the Act);
- not have had their Certificate of Authority suspended or revoked;
- never been levied a penalty under Section 480 (1)(a) of the Act, and not have been levied a penalty in the preceding five years under Section 480 (1) (b, c, d, or e) of the Act;
- not be an employee of an insurer licensed to undertake life insurance;

Full eligibility requirements can be found in **Sections 5 and 29** of the *Insurance Councils Regulation* by [clicking here](#).

No individual may be nominated as a candidate for membership on more than one Council at the same time, nor may they be a candidate for membership or a member on a Council and Appeal Board at the same time.

What are the expectations of a nominee if elected?

A position on the Life Insurance Council holds a term of three years, meeting once per month.

Compensation is paid on a per diem basis in addition to expenses directly associated with attending to Life Insurance Council business.

How do I nominate a candidate?

All inquiries and nominations may be submitted to the Alberta Insurance Council by email to elections@abcouncil.ab.ca. Requirements for nomination are as follows:

- A letter of nomination signed by a minimum of five licensed life insurance agents.
- A brief biography for the candidate (with optional headshot) that may be distributed to eligible voters (maximum 12 lines).
- **Nominations must be received no later than 4:30 pm on July 8, 2019.**
